EWR's total passenger traffic grew a solid 4%. Domestic traffic was the biggest contributor, growing 4.2%. United, Virgin America, US Airways, Southwest and Alaska Airlines collectively carried 102,000 more passengers. United, a dominant carrier at EWR, contributed the most by boosting capacity to California, Texas, Washington DC, Portland and Virginia. International sector gained 3.6%. United, Delta, Icelandair, Porter Airlines, Jet Airways and TACA together carried 35,600 more passengers. Cargo sector fell 14.3% with domestic down 20.7% and international decreased 2%. FedEx contributed the most to domestic cargo decline. It accounted for 6,760 tons out of total 8,760-ton reduction. The consolidation of Kalitta Air from EWR to JFK was the main factor in the drop of international cargo
