

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

JFK served 1.8 million domestic and 1.9 million international passengers, a total of 3.7 million in November. Although this is a 0.6% decrease for the month, the YTD total stands at 46.1 million, an increase of 1.9%. This increase is attributed to the airport's international traffic, which has been an engine of growth since the start of the year. Reaching 24.3 million passengers YTD, up 5.4%, international passenger traffic notably exceeded 21.9 million YTD domestic traffic. Delta, JetBlue, Emirates, Norwegian, Virgin Atlantic, British Airways, Air China and Air Berlin collectively carried 100,400 more passengers. Airport's total cargo tonnage was up 5.3% due to strong international freight activity, which grew a solid 7.1%. This jump pushed YTD cargo up to positive 0.2%.
