

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ NOVEMBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

LGA served 2.1 million passengers, a tepid increase of 0.7%. Domestic traffic was flat. The dominant carriers decreased domestic seat capacity by 4.2%, even though traffic growth was unchanged, suggesting fuller planes. Southwest, United, Spirit, American and Frontier Airlines collectively served 35,500 more passengers on domestic routes. Southwest Airlines was the biggest contributor launching services to Houston, Nashville and Atlanta. In contrast, JetBlue, US Airways and Delta collectively carried 34,900 fewer passengers following their seat capacity decreases. International passenger traffic, although relatively small compared to domestic, increased a hefty 11.8 percent. The engine of growth was Delta, which launched service to Bermuda. Cargo business remained weak and declined 18.1%.
