

Aviation Department

Air travel at LGA increased 1.4%, with domestic and international traffic growing 1.3 and 1.7% respectively. With 24.5 million passengers YTD November, LGA established an all-time passenger traffic record. Robust international travel, which was up 5.7% YTD, contributed the most to the growth. WestJet and Air Canada combined carried 11,400 more passengers to Canadian destinations. Southwest Airlines continued to make significant contributions to our domestic increase as it carried 32,600 more passengers, a 20.2% jump. JetBlue and Delta combined carried 37,600 more passengers. However, American and US Airway's combined passenger traffic was down 6%, serving 35,900 fewer passengers.
