Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

## Aviation Department

Our airports served 107.2 million passengers YTD November - 3.2% higher than passenger traffic for the same period last year. Following a record-setting October, November set a new peak with nine million passengers traveling through our facilities, a 4.7% increase over November of last year. Domestic traffic was up 4.5%, putting YTD in the black by 1.8%. International traffic increased 5% for the month. These increases were due to a relatively strong Thanksgiving travel period, which led to seat capacity expansion and relatively high load factors. Steady U.S. economy growth, rapidly decreasing oil prices, and the continued strength of the U.S. dollar are lifting passenger traffic above our predicted rate for 2014. The region's cargo increased 1.5%, as international tonnage, which accounts for nearly 70% of our total, expanded 2.6%, marking the ninth consecutive month of growth in this sector, and domestic cargo decreased 0.6%. YTD November growth stands at 0.8%.
