

Regional passenger traffic grew 4.8% on a 3.1% rise in seat capacity. International growth led domestic by 6.1% to 4.3%. Regional growth was favorable measured against an American Transport Association (ATA) member airline growth average of 2.1%, split between a (1.6%) domestic drop and 7.3% international growth. Regional freight traffic increased 3.67%.
