Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger traffic rose 4.4% on a 3.3% increase in seat capacity. American Transport Association member traffic rose 1.3%. JFK continues to lead the region with 8.9% passenger growth followed by Newark Liberty with a 3.0% gain. LaGuardia passenger traffic declined (1%) -- inline with its (0.8%) loss in seat capacity. Regional Freight declined (2.3%), with 12-month ending freight down (1.4%). ATA member revenue freight ton miles rose 2.8% in October.
