

Aviation Department

Relatively small in comparison with the rest of the Port Authority airport system, Stewart's passenger traffic fell 1.3% on an 11.9% increase in flights and 8.9% increase in scheduled seat capacity. Overall, Stewart's schedules have displayed stability following a tumultuous 2008.
