

## Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic declined 0.2 percent on 1.7 percent more scheduled seats, reducing its load factor two-percentage points. Passenger growth split between a 2 percent domestic loss and 1.6 percent international gain, with domestic seats flat and international seats gaining by 3.4 percent. By region, transatlantic passenger traffic fell 1.3%. Canadian traffic fell 8.5 percent, while Latin American markets grew 2.4 percent. Transpacific traffic increased 2 percent, marking six straight months of growth. JFK freight volume decreased 9.4 percent.
