LaGuardia traffic fell 3 percent with a 3.3 percent domestic loss and 4.1 percent international gain. Overall, scheduled seats at LaGuardia fell by 1.1 percent, while Canadian seats increased by 12.6 percent. JetBlue won 8-slot pairs in the auction held by the DOT, while Canadian airline Westjet won the other 8-slot pairs. With new slots in place, Delta will operate 250 daily departures.
