Hurricane Sandy closed all three major commercial airports last October, so this month's passenger traffic is highly distorted. Passenger traffic increased 9.5%, with domestic growing 4.3% and international jumping 14.6%. With 4.2 million passengers this month, the YTD total stands at 42.4 million, a growth rate of 2.1%. Even though domestic levels increased, the YTD figure is still down 1.6% because the airport's dominant carriers, JetBlue and Delta (with a combined 65% share in domestic destinations), have been cutting seat capacity since the start of the year. With the seat capacity down but actual passengers up, planes operated fuller this month. In contrast to domestic, international passenger traffic experienced a double-digit increase. This increase primarily originated from transatlantic and transpacific markets.
