

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Combined international and domestic traffic increased a hefty 6.6% because of Hurricane Sandy distortions. YTD is up 4.1%, reaching 22.2 million passengers. The dominant carriers decreased seat capacity by 3.5%, even though traffic is up, suggesting fuller planes. The airlines served 124,000 more passengers in their domestic destinations, with American, US Airways, Southwest and United contributing the most. Delta, the dominant carrier with almost 40% of the airport's share, cut the seat capacity by 6.3% and returned flat results. International traffic is up 14%, pushing YTD to 22.2%. Similar to domestic, carriers cut international seat capacity while passenger traffic increased. The largest contributor is Air Canada, which boosted traffic to Montreal.
