

Aviation Department

JFK was a major driver behind the region's record air travel so far. It accounted for 46% of the region's YTD October travel, or 44.8 million passengers. With 6.9% increase, October 2014 was the airport's seventh consecutive record-setting month with 4.5 million passengers traveling through the airport. International travel increased 5.9% and domestic air travel saw the best increase so far with 7.9% jump. These increases pushed YTD October up to 5.7%. Cargo tonnage declined 0.6% at JFK in October. Even though international tonnage increased by 2%, a hefty 10.8% contraction in domestic cargo brought the levels down.
