

Aviation Department

Air travel at LGA increased 1.4% in October. Both domestic and international grew 1.2% and 4.6% respectively. With 22.4 million passengers YTD October, LGA established an all-time passenger traffic record. This record is due to international travel, which easily eclipsed the previous record by 6.1%. Three out of four carriers serving international markets combined carried 14,000 more passengers primarily to Canadian destinations, a 10% increase. Southwest Airlines contributed the most to a domestic increase as it carried 17.7% more passengers. JetBlue, US Airways, Delta, Spirit and United combined carried 43,400 more passengers. However, American's passenger traffic was down 11.1%.
