

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

October passenger traffic performance at ACY continues to disappoint as activity fell 4.3 percent, in spite of 0.8 percent increase in overall seat capacity. Growth for the airport's dominant carrier, Spirit Airlines, was at a virtual standstill as traffic increased only 0.7 percent. The overall decline was severe because of an 11.7 percent drop in domestic charter activity. The reduced charter activity is related to the decline in the city's casino business. Because its activity is seasonal, new carrier Air Canada did not provide any offset to the losses resulting from United Airlines leaving the market.
