

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at SWF continues to deteriorate as it fell 15.9 percent in October, with 4,233 fewer passengers. As a result, YTD traffic is down 9.4 percent. With no recovery expected, year-end traffic is likely to fall 9.6 percent compared to 2014. Seat capacity was down 17.4 percent. All four carriers operating at the airport, including low-cost Allegiant Air, experienced declines in October. US Airways declined the most due to service cessation to its hub in Philadelphia, followed by Delta as it reduced services to Detroit. Stewart's cargo fell a modest 0.7 percent.
