

Aviation Department

Due to Hurricane Sandy, EWR's October traffic was also down 8.3%, as domestic and international traffic fell 7.1% and 10.8% respectively. EWR was closed from 9 pm October 29th to early morning October 31st. However, YTD October growth remained above 1.7% due mainly to the strength of the growth in the previous 9 months. Again, cargo remained extremely disappointing as its level fell 15% in October and YTD October declined 9.2%.
