

Aviation Department

Due to Hurricane Sandy, JFK's October traffic was also down 3.8%, as domestic and international traffic fell 4.5% and 3.1% respectively. JFK was closed from 8:50 pm October 29th to noon October 31st. Nevertheless, YTD October growth remained above 3.6% due to robust growth in the previous 9 months. Again the disappointment is in the cargo sector where cargo fell 8.5% in October and YTD October declined 5.9%.
