The record pace of passenger growth continued as the region's total passenger volume reached a new November mark of 11.141 million travelers (+621,911 passengers/+5.9 percent). The domestic sector led growth, handling a record 7.392 million travelers (+427,316 passengers/+6.1 percent). The international sector also achieved a new record of 3.749 million passengers (+194,595 passengers/+5.5 percent). Carriers increased total seat capacity by 5 percent. Domestic seats expanded by 3.9 percent. International seats climbed by 7.2 percent. The region's total freight volume registered its first decline of 2018 (-1,293 tons/-0.6 percent). International cargo led the falloff with a 2.1 percent dip (-2,637 tons). In contrast, domestic cargo traffic (about 36 percent of our region's total freight), posted its 10th consecutive monthly gain (+1,344 tons/+1.8 percent).
