The torrid growth pace set in the first six months of 2016 evaporated as the region's passenger grew only 0.8 percent. In spite of the tepid growth rate, the region set another record as it reached an all-time July high of 12.1 million passengers - a gain of 102,000 travelers compared to July 2015. The international sector led the growth with a 4 percent gain and set a new record of 4.7 million passengers. Domestic traffic fell by 1.1 percent - the first monthly decline since February 2014. Following a modest rebound of 1 percent in June, the region's total cargo activity experienced its sixth monthly decline of 2016. While domestic freight activity decreased 1.5 percent, international cargo, which accounts for approximately 65 percent of the region's total freight movement, grew by 0.4 percent
