

## Aviation Department

Stewart traffic was down 8.6% although seat capacity increased 8.7%. JetBlue flew 1.3 thousand or 9.5% fewer passengers to Florida. Delta's traffic was down 3.2% as it upped seat capacity by 3.8%. US Airways 28.0% expansion in seat capacity resulted to a 13.2% increase in traffic to its Philadelphia hub.
