

Aviation Department

Kennedy traffic grew 2.6 percent on 2.8 percent more scheduled seats. Passenger growth was divided between domestic and international gains of 1.9 percent and 3.3 respectively. Domestic seats grew 2.8 percent, right in line with the 2.9 percent growth for international seats. By world grouping, all Kennedy markets were positive. Freight decreased 3.9 percent, with a 2.4 percent domestic and a 4.1 percent international decline. Freighter operations declined 3.6 percent.
