

Aviation Department

Stewart passenger volume grew 7.2 percent, the highest among our airports, despite JetBlue dropping its second Orlando nonstop after Labor Day. Airport seat capacity rose by 10.6 percent. Stewart freighter operations declined by 1 percent year-over-year.
