

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2012 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

JFK continued the pattern established in the first half as airlines cut domestic capacity and left international flat. However, planes were much fuller, and YTD Sept. grew 4.4%. International and domestic traffic were also up 5.8% and 3.0% respectively. Net gain of YTD Sept. domestic and international each exceeded 500,000 passengers, led by JetBlue, Delta and Caribbean. Again, the disappointment was in the cargo sector where cargo continued to remain weak and YTD Sept. cargo fell 5.6%.
