

Aviation Department

LGA continued to be the fastest growing airport among our facilities with an YTD Sept. gain of 7.1%. YTD September domestic passengers grew 5.8% for a net gain of 998,000 passengers. Delta continued to be the domestic growth leader, increasing its domestic seat capacity by 17%, as it used its newly acquired slots to expand services to more than 20 new domestic destinations. The international sector continued its double-digit drive with growth of 36%, led by Delta's services to Nassau and by Air Canada and new carrier West Jet's services to Toronto.
