

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

4.2 million passengers used JFK this month, a 1.4% increase over the Sept. of 2012. This put YTD Sept. growth at 1.3%. All of JFK's growth emanated from the international sector, where YTD Sept. traffic rose 4.6%, aided by a 3.6% gain in seat capacity. International growth was led by Delta, JetBlue, Virgin Atlantic and Aeroflot. Domestic traffic continued the pattern established in the first half as airlines cut YTD September domestic capacity by 1.6%. As a result, domestic traffic fell 2.2%. Contributing to the decline were JetBlue, Delta and Virgin America, which collectively reduced domestic capacity by 3.9% and carried 600,000 fewer passengers. Again the disappointment was in the cargo sector where cargo continued to remain weak and YTD Sept. cargo fell 1.7%.
