

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2013 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

YTD traffic at SWF is down 16.4%. This represents an improvement of four percentage points from YTD June data. Traffic was up 4% in September, the first monthly gain since March 2012. Each of the three carriers at SWF showed gains in September, and we anticipate monthly traffic to show continued improvement for two reasons: Carriers are maintaining current capacity levels while traffic demand improves, and Allegiant, a low-cost-carrier, introduced new service to Tampa in late October. The year-end passenger decline should fall below 10%.
