

Aviation Department

LGA's YTD Sept. traffic was up 0.8%. YTD September domestic traffic was up 0.4% . With the exception of Southwest's 22% capacity gain to Houston and Atlanta and slight gains by Spirit, demand from legacy carriers American, Delta and JetBlue was down. The international sector, which makes up just 6.8% of the airport's traffic, remains strong, with 6.3% growth led by Air Canada, WestJet and American.
