SWF's YTD September traffic was down 2.5% because JetBlue, the airport's No. 1 carrier, reduced seat capacity to Orlando by 31% and carried 24,600 fewer passengers. Allegiant Air continues to be a bright spot, averaging about 2,500 passengers monthly. SWF's YTD Sept Cargo is down 14.4%.
