

Aviation Department

At ACY, the airport's dominant carrier, Spirit's passengers are up 2.2%. YTD Sept. growth, and overall scheduled activity is up 0.3%, but ACY's YTD Sept. traffic is still down 1.4 percent. The weakness is attributable to dramatic declines in charter activity. There were 12,641 fewer charter passengers as YTD domestic charter traffic was down 15.5% and international was down 45%.
