

## Aviation Department

YTD Sept passenger traffic grew 4.4%, led by a domestic sector which gained 6.7%, assisted by 5.2% gain in seat capacity for a net gain of nearly a million passengers. Attesting to the notion that its merger pains are nearly resolved, United contributed about 90% of the net gains as it expanded seat capacity by 6% to places such as Atlanta, Dallas Fort Worth, New Orleans, Pittsburgh and West Palm Beach. In contrast, YTD Sept. international traffic fell 0.1 %. United reduced capacity by 0.5 % and ceased direct services to Stuttgart, Germany, and Edmonton and Moncton in Canada. All international regions experienced a decline except Caribbean/Bermuda and Mexico. Freight at EWR continues to lead the region's cargo growth, gaining 5.2% in Sept and lifting YTD Sept. cargo growth to 6.7%.
