

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ APRIL 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

SWF's total passenger traffic saw 1,925 fewer passengers, down 8 percent. The decline was led by a 32.2 percent reduction by Delta. Meanwhile, JetBlue saw a 5.5 percent fall in passenger traffic. Airlines cut seat capacity by 6.9 percent, down 2,024 seats. Delta led the reduction in seat capacity with a 33.3 percent cut (2,700 seats) to Detroit. Stewart's cargo movement inched down 0.4 percent. The main driver of this fall was UPS, which transported 107 fewer tons for a 24.9 percent drop. Meanwhile, FedEx showed a solid 15 percent increase in cargo activity. However, this growth did not offset the deficit created by UPS.
