

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at SWF fell for the third consecutive month - down 6.6 percent, or 1,603 fewer passengers. The decline was led by American/US Air, Delta, and JetBlue, all of which experienced double-digit drops in their passenger traffic. Airlines cut domestic seat capacity by 4.7 percent. Delta and American/US Airways slashed their seats to Detroit and Philadelphia by 24.3 and 19.7 percent respectively. Freight activity at Stewart soared 37.8 percent - the highest growth rate among our airports - for an improvement of 420 short tons. Growth was totally sustained by FedEx's 65.2 percent jump (an extra 461 short tons), as all the other carriers experienced declines.
