

## Aviation Department

SWF's total passenger traffic fell 15.3 percent, or 3,974 fewer passengers. The decline was led by a 24.5 percent plunge by Delta. American/US Air and JetBlue experienced double-digit dips in their passenger traffic as well, down 19 and 10.2 percent respectively. Airlines cut seat capacity by 7.1 percent, with Delta slashing its seats to Detroit by 25 percent and American/US Airways reducing its seats to Philadelphia by 5.2 percent. Freight activity at Stewart fell by just 0.2 percent, or down 1 ton. While FedEx carried an extra 86 tons and grew 12 percent, UPS and JetBlue jointly carried 87 fewer tons.
