The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

May passenger traffic is up a strong 8.3% in the region -- led by domestic growth exceeding industry averages as measured by ATA reported May traffic.
