

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at ACY improved by 3.9 percent – 4,357 additional passengers. Growth was led totally by the domestic sector as international passenger traffic was down 87 percent due to Air Canada's cessation of operations at ACY. In August 2016, Air Canada carried 1,681 passengers. Spirit grew its passenger movement by 8.5 percent gain – 8,193 extra passengers. This solid improvement compensated for an 18 percent (2,156 passengers) fall in domestic charter activity. Spirit, the dominant carrier at ACY, grew its seats by 8.7 percent – up 9,300 seats. As we stated in the July Monthly Traffic Report, plans by Spirit to begin services at EWR to Orlando and Fort Lauderdale in the last quarter of 2016 likely will adversely impact ACY's passenger traffic.
