

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Boosted by stronger-than-anticipated growth in the first quarter and the final month of the year, ACY ended the year down only 0.9 %. The primary cause of ACY's decline was the 14.3 % drop in charter activity that caused the airport to carry 18,445 fewer charter passengers. The reduced charter activity is related to a decline in the city's casino business. With no potential turnaround in sight, charter will continue to be a drag on ACY's growth potential. ACY gained a new carrier in 2015, Air Canada. Because its activities are seasonal, Air Canada carried only 2,357 passengers, not enough to counter the volume lost from of United's departure.
