EWR was the fastest-growing facility among our airport system, registering a 7.6 percent passenger traffic gain – 40.3 million passengers used the airport in 2016. This represents the airport's highest total ever, exceeding the record set last year by 2.8 million passengers. Among its other 2016 accomplishments, EWR broke its domestic passenger high set last year, handling 27.9 million passengers. This level translated into a passenger growth of 9.1 percent, a net gain of 2 million. The international sector also set an all-time record as it handled 12.3 million passengers, for a 4.4 percent gain. Similar to passenger traffic, EWR cargo's led the region cargo growth for the second consecutive year with a gain of 5.9 percent. Growth was led by the domestic sector - up 8.1 percent. International cargo was less robust - up 2.1 percent.
