For the fourth straight year, JFK set three different records: total, international and domestic passengers. Overall, the airport handled 58.9 million passengers, which translated into growth of 3.6 percent, or 2.1 million more passengers than 2015. With 31.7 million passengers and a gain of 5.4 percent, JFK's international passenger sector exceeded domestic passenger levels for the ninth year in a row. The domestic sector set a new record by handling 27.2 million passengers for a net gain of nearly half a million travelers and growth of 1.6 percent over 2015. For the second consecutive year, JFK's cargo declined – down 1.3 percent in 2016 – following a 0.8 percent fall in 2015. After losing momentum in mid-June 2015, JFK cargo truly recovered, despite sporadic progress in the domestic sector, which was up 2.5 percent in 2016.
