This workshop is for M/WBEs interested in upcoming opportunities at the WTC Vehicular Security Center and the WTC Streets Infrastructure. Representatives from Tishman Construction Corporation of New York, the construction manager, and the Port Authority of NY & NJ will provide an overview of the projects, the prequalification requirements to bid, as well as information on upcoming opportunities tied to trades specified below. Attendees who are principals/officers of their firms may wish to participate in the second part of the workshop: to undergo Security Information Management (SIM) training and complete the non-disclosure agreement form.

1. World Trade Center Vehicular Security Center

Work Packages (\$1 million - \$5 million range): Masonry / Roofing and Waterproofing / Carpentry / Hoist and Shed / Overhead Doors / Spray on Fireproofing / Painting/General Contracting Finishes (ceramic, storefront, flooring, toilet accessories and compartment, signage) / Parking Specialties (signage, stripping, guard booths, motorized gates, vehicle scales, etc.)

2. World Trade Center Streets Infrastructure

Site Work Packages (\$1 million - \$5 million range) Package 2 - East Bathtub, Package 3 - 1 WTC, Package 4 - Liberty Street): General Contracting - Heavy / Paving and Utilities / Concrete / Site Work

1. PANYNJ business qualification questionnaire
2. Secure Worker Access Consortium Confirmation and Security Information Management (SIM) training;
3. Non-disclosure agreement from the Port Authority of NY & NJ's Security Information Management handbook;
4. Tishman Construction on-line pre-qualification.
