The Port Authority of New York & New Jersey (“Authority”) hereby amends the subject Request for Proposals (RFP) letter, dated July 31, 2014, as follows:

RFP Letter –

Page 4, Section IV. SELECTION PROCESS, delete A. - C. in their entirety and replace with:

- A. Qualifications and experience of the proposed staff, including sub-consultant(s) staff;
- B. Qualifications and experience of the firm;
- C. Technical Approach; and
- D. Management Approach

Page 4, Section VI, ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, delete first paragraph in its entirety starting with “*The selected Consultant*” and ending with “*National Tolling Standards*”.

The following question was received from an RFP recipient. The question and corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

*Q. Attachment A, Section 3, Task B. - Are firms representing other users/owners (i.e. MTA, NYSTA, NYSBA) of the NYCSC in relation to the current NYCSC re-procurement precluded from this project or any particular task(s)?*

*A. The firm is not excluded from proposing on this project or any particular task but the staff assigned to perform Authority work should not be the same staff assigned to perform the work for other agencies.*

The due date for receipt of proposals has been extended to **2:00 P.M. on August 28, 2014.**
