The following questions were received from RFP recipient(s). The questions and corresponding Authority answers are provided for your information and use, as appropriate:

Would the services provided in the above-mentioned RFP for design of two multi-span bridge structure be a conflict of interest for program management services contract holders? If so, would this only exclude the program management contract holders from being prime on the design or the exclusion applies to a subconsultant role as well?

Response: If the Proposer or any employee, agent or subconsultant of the Proposer may have a possible conflict of interest, or may give the appearance of a possible conflict of interest, the Proposer shall include in its proposal a statement indicating the nature of the conflict, and should include a plan for mitigating said conflict. The Authority reserves the right to disqualify the Proposer if, in its sole discretion, any interest disclosed from any source could create a conflict of interest or give the appearance of a conflict of interest. The Authority's determination regarding any questions of conflict of interest shall be final.
