## **ADDENDUM # 1**

To prospective Bidders on Bid #44810 for Converters and Inverters, Including Testing, for PATH's Optical Network:

**The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation document:**

- a) Insert the following new paragraphs after the "FTA Bid Submission Requirements" on page 1 of the Request for Quotation form:**

"Brand name or equal descriptions are used as a means to define the performance or other salient characteristics of procurements. In the subject Bid, even if the phrase "or approved equal" is inadvertently omitted, it is implied after any brand name.

The prices quoted on this Request for Quotation form shall be in United States Dollars. All figures inserted will be interpreted as being quoted in United States Dollars."

- b) Insert the following as paragraph 3 under "Additional Bid Submission Requirements" on page 2 of the Request for Quotation form:**

3. Where the Bidder is quoting a proposed equal, the Bidder shall submit two (2) copies of specification sheets or other documentation on the proposed equal to facilitate a comparison to the product specified herein.

Please note that PATH, as required for further evaluation, may request delivery of a sample of the proposed equal product, at the Bidder's expense, to determine if the performance requirements and characteristics of the proposed alternate product meet the requirements of the product specified herein. Failure to provide a sample or additional information within a specified timeframe, if requested by PATH to conduct its evaluation, may result in rejection of the alternate product and/or rejection of the bid. A sample that is approved, deemed in new condition, and usable by PATH will be accepted toward the order under this Contract. The Bidder shall pick up samples

that are not approved within thirty (30) days of notification, after which time all samples will become the property of PATH.

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
