I. CHANGES TO BID DOCUMENTS

The following changes are hereby made to the Bid Documents:

- The bid due date has been extended until 6/16/16, no later than 11:00 A.M.
- In Part II, "Contract Specific Information for Bidders", Page 4, Paragraph 13, "Evaluation of Bids", in the third paragraph, after the word "Section" delete "I and replace it with "A"; in the fourth paragraph, after the word "Section", delete "II" and replace it with "B". In the final paragraph, delete "I" and "II" and replace them with "A" and "B" respectively.

II. BIDDERS' QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions, which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidders does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.
