ADDENDUM #1

To prospective firms submitting qualifications in response to the Request to Qualify (“RTQ”) for Construction Management / General Contracting Services for the LaGuardia Airport Capital Infrastructure (LGACI) Program - Contract LGA-124.223

Due back on July 16, 2013 no later than 4:00 P.M.

The following changes are hereby made to the RTQ document:

Section I. INTRODUCTION: after the third paragraph, insert:

“The firm (or joint venture, and if a joint venture, each member, individually) awarded this Contract for “Construction Management/General Contracting Services for the LaGuardia Airport Capital Infrastructure (LGACI) Program” shall be precluded from participating on a Proposer team, or acting as a Key Firm to a Proposer team, for the LaGuardia Airport Central Terminal Building Replacement Project. However, any firm who is qualified under this RTQ and who ultimately is selected as the successful firm for this Contract shall not be precluded from participating in any future procurements for supporting projects under the LaGuardia Capital Infrastructure (LGACI) Program, which includes the construction of roadways and utilities, the demolition of Hangars 2 and 4 and construction of new East and West parking garages. Further, the firm (or joint venture, and if a joint venture, each member, individually) is prohibited from self-performing any tasks issued via work order by the Authority, unless otherwise directed by the Authority.”

Section III.B.6 Joint Ventures, delete:

“The Authority will entertain requests for prequalification from single entities only”

and replace with

“The Authority will entertain requests for prequalification from a joint venture. If a joint venture is pre-qualified to submit bids, or if two or more entities separately pre-qualified to bid elect to submit a bid as a joint venture, all participants in the joint venture shall be bound jointly and severally and each participant shall execute the bid. If the prospective bidder cannot demonstrate that it meets all of the referenced qualifications, then the prospective bidder may with others form a joint venture and request that the joint venture be deemed to be the prospective bidder (i.e. members of the joint venture may meet the qualification requirement collectively.)”

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your submission. In case your firm fails to conform to these instructions, its response will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
