I. CHANGES TO BID DOCUMENTS

The following changes are hereby made to the bid documents.

- The bid due date is extended until 6/19/2015 no later than 11:00 A.M.
- Part IV, “Signature Sheet, Name And Residence Of Principals Sheet And Pricing Sheet(s)”, replace Page 7 “Pricing Sheets – Section II – Bathgate Industrial Park” with the attached “Pricing Sheets – Section II – Bathgate Industrial Park - Revised 6/12/2015”.
- In Part V “Specifications”, Page 7, Section 5: “Section II – Bathgate Industrial Park”:
 - “Item B1- On-Call”, in the first sentence, delete “Three (3)” and replace it with “Two (2)”. In the second last sentence, delete “one-hundred fifty-six (156)” and replace it with “twelve (12)”.
 - “Item B2- On-Call”, in the first sentence, delete “Two (2)” and replace it with “One (1)”. In the second last sentence, delete “one-hundred four (104)” and replace it with “six (6)”.

II. BIDDERS' QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.
