ADDENDUM #2

To prospective bidder(s) on Bid # 44912 – “World Trade Center (WTC) Flood Mitigation and Resiliency Improvements Program –Bollard Protection System at the Memorial and Street Closures”

Due back on 2/16/2016, no later than 11:00 AM

The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation documents:

1. Delete the entire text of the “Information for Bidders,” Section 1, Paragraph 1 entitled “**Form and Submission of Bids**” and **substitute the following:**

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey ("Authority") invites Bids in the annexed form. Bids will be received until 11:00 am on **February 16, 2016** in the office of the Chief of Procurement, Attn: Bid Custodian, **4 World Trade Center (4WTC), 150 Greenwich Street, 21st Floor, New York, NY 10007**, at which time they will be opened and publicly read in the Bid Room. Each Bid must be contained in an envelope, which shall be sealed and conspicuously endorsed with the bidder's name and the number of this Contract.

2. Delete the entire text of Chapter I, Section 22, Paragraph 4 entitled “**General Conditions**” and **substitute the following:**

Chapter 1, Section 22, Paragraph 4

"Work" shall mean all structures, equipment, plant, labor, materials (including materials and equipment, if any, furnished by the Authority) and other facilities and all other things necessary or proper for or incidental to the (1) furnishing and installation at the construction site of a bollard protection system, from an approved manufacturer, for flood control, including labor and materials, and (2) its removal to storage as specified, complete and in place, both within **240 days** of receipt of a written notice to proceed .

3. Delete the entire text of Chapter I, Section 23, Paragraph 4 entitled “**General Agreement**” and substitute the following:

Chapter I, Section 23, Paragraph 4:

The Contractor agrees to perform the Work required for the (1) furnishing and installation at the construction site of a bollard protection system, from an approved manufacturer, for flood control, including labor and materials, and (2) its removal to storage as specified, complete and in place, both within **240 days** of receipt of a written notice to proceed.

4. Delete the entire text of Chapter III, Section 40, Paragraph 1 entitled “**Time For Completion and Damages for delay and Incentives**” and substitute the following:

Chapter III, Section 40 and Paragraph 1:

The Contractor shall complete the performance of all Work under this Contract within **240 days** of receipt of a written notice to proceed, following the schedule outlined below.

Substantial Completion within **180 calendar days**

5. Delete the entire text of Division I, Section 1, Paragraph 1 entitled “**Construction required by the Specifications**” and substitute the following:

Division I, Section 1 and Paragraph 1

These Specifications relate generally to the (1) furnishing and installation at the construction site of a bollard protection system, from an approved manufacturer, for flood control, including labor and materials, and (2) its removal to storage as specified, complete and in place, both within **240 days** of receipt of a written notice to proceed. These Specifications require the doing of all things necessary or proper for or incidental to the Work referred to in the immediately preceding paragraph, as shown on the Contract Drawings in their present form. In addition, all things shown on the Contract Drawings even though not expressly mentioned in these Specifications, all things mentioned in these Specifications even though not shown on the Contract Drawings, and all things not specified either on the Contract Drawings, or in the Specifications but involved in carrying out their intent and in the complete and proper execution of the matter referred to in the immediately preceding paragraph are required by these Specifications; and the Contractor shall perform the same as though they were specifically delineated, described and mentioned herein.

6. **RFI due date – Thursday February 11, 2016 by 12 P.M**

7. Delete the Goal listed in Section 9B, of the Information For Bidders, entitled **“Goal” and substitute the following:**

DBE Participation Goal: 7%

8. Delete 05110 Perimeter Flood Barrier from the Table of Content section labeled **“Technical Specifications” and substitute the following:**

05110 Perimeter Flood Barrier
