Adequacy of the delivery equipment is determined on the vendor awarded the purchase order and is responsible including any subcontractor (e.g. shipping company/delivery service) it may use for the successful load they are delivering. It is the vendor's responsibility to know what the product they are delivering, weights, size, capacity, etc. and having equipment that can off-load it on-site. The vendor including its shipper has to get the material ordered off the truck / flat / semi-trailer, vehicle etc. and successfully place it on PATH property coordinated with the person indicated for the delivery. PATH will not supply any equipment or labor to unload said cable.

The following answers to questions shall become an integral part of the subject Bid.

<p><i>Question #2</i></p>	<p>Will a truck equipped with a Hydraulic Lift gate and pallet jack of sufficient capacity to move the reel off the Lift gate be sufficient to meet the requirement?</p> <p>If the Lift gate is sufficient is there a need for the flatbed or will an enclosed truck with Lift gate be sufficient.</p> <p>If the Lift gate is not sufficient please specify either specify the type and capacity of the equipment required (boom truck or crane, reach and positive or negative height capacity) OR the specifics of the delivery location and requirement (i.e. must lift over a 3 foot high wall 8 feet to the side of the closest location a truck with boom can be safely operated; i.e. load must be dropped into manhole 8 feet to the rear of the trucks parked location. ect.)</p>
