SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF EXPERT PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR PORT NEWARK PORT STREET CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENTS (RFP# 36024) – ADDENDUM #3

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey hereby amends the subject Request for Proposals, dated December 20, 2013 as follows:

In the Attachment A, Section III, under Task I, item number 12, second paragraph, delete “7 and 8” in its entirety, and replace it with “8 and 9”.

The following question(s) from RFP recipient(s) and corresponding Authority answer(s) are provided for your information and use, as appropriate:

In the RFP letter, Section I, item D: the principal/lead engineer must have a minimum of 10 years of experience for elements listed in Attachment A. Is the Authority asking for one-person to have 10 years of experience in all areas noted in Attachment A (ITS, traffic, bridges/structures, environmental, etc.)?

The Lead Engineer leading the work of each discipline as listed in Attachment A must have 10-years of relevant experience.

In Attachment A, Section III, Task F, item 4a: Is it the Authority’s intent that the Consultant sign and seal construction drawings based on geotechnical design performed by the Authority?

Geotechnical Design documents (typically notes) prepared by the Authority will be signed by the Authority. The Authority will provide the Structural Consultant with the required geotechnical information necessary to complete the structural design. Foundation elements are shown on the Structural drawings.

In Attachment A, Section III, Task F, item 10: What is meant by “supporting documentation” of all permits listed in Section 3? (e.g. Is the Consultant responsible for wetland delineation?)

The Consultant is responsible to provide the Authority with signed and sealed drawings, as required, for permit applications when requested to do so by the Authority.

The due date for receipt of proposals remains no later than 2:00 pm on January 24, 2014.
