Dear Sir or Madam:

The following question is from an RFP recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

Question: Can the Architectural and Engineering firm that is awarded the subject Agreement for environmental assessment (EA) services as required under this RFP, also propose on future final design phases for this project?

Answer: Once the EA services required under this RFP are completed, the consultant may propose on future services regarding this project. However, the Consultant cannot simultaneously perform the EA services and perform design and engineering services that depends on the results of this EA study.

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey hereby amends the subject Request for Proposals (RFP), dated March 6, 2015 as follows:

In the Attachment A, page 5, Task E. Project Schedule and Monthly Progress Reports, Item 1., first sentence, delete the phrase “Primavera-based Critical path Method Project” and replace with “Microsoft Project 2007”.

In the RFP Letter, page 5, Section J(i), delete “to provide expert professional services in connection with the Project” and replace with “preparation of this RFP”.

In the RFP letter, page 2, delete item C. in its entirety and replace with the following:

All proposals must be delivered in sealed envelopes and/or packages.

As of March 30, 2015, the Procurement Department will be located at 4 World Trade Center (4 WTC) located at 150 Greenwich St., 21st Floor, New York, New York, 10006.

There is extensive security at the World Trade Center Site. You must present a valid government-issued photo ID to enter 4 WTC. Individuals without packages or carrying small packages, envelopes or boxes that can be conveyed by hand or on a hand truck may enter through the lobby. All packages, envelopes and boxes may be subject to additional security screening.

There is no parking available at 4 WTC/150 Greenwich Street, and parking in the surrounding area is extremely limited.

Express carrier deliveries by commercial vehicles will only be made via vendors approved by Silverstein Properties, the WTC Property Manager, through the Vehicle Security Center (VSC). Presently, UPS is the only delivery vendor with approved recurring delivery times. UPS makes deliveries to 4 WTC around 9:30 a.m. each day. Please plan your submission accordingly. As additional express carriers may be approved by Silverstein Properties and scheduled for recurring delivery times with the VSC, this information may be updated.

Under certain circumstances, a solicitation may allow for a commercial vehicle to be approved to make a delivery in accordance with the VSC procedures. If applicable, the specific solicitation document will include that information.

The Port Authority assumes no responsibility for delays, including, but not limited to, delays caused by any delivery services, building access procedures, or security requirements.

The date for receipt of proposals for the subject RFP remains 2:00 P.M. on April 2, 2015.
